Why learn German?

Knowledge of the German language is indispensable for living and working in Austria.

Proficiency in German will determine the job and career opportunities in Austria. The personal commitment to learning the German language will pay.



How to learn German?

For nationals of third states who sign the integration agreement, there are **required minimum language skills** if they wish to settle down in Austria permanently:

Before entering the country ...

...learn German at A1 level.

After entering the country ...

...sign the integration agreement

...learning German at A2 level within two years.

In order to stay in Austria permanently (obtaining Austrian citizenship) ...

... learn the language at B1 level.

Habibi Job Center

The ÖIF **Job Center in Habibi** provides individual support to migrants and beneficiaries of asylum in their **integration into the labor market.**

The goal is to create **successful employment** by working with job seekers and employers.

- Job orientation
- Counseling on education and training
- Support in the job search
- Help preparing job application material
- Calling potential employers
- Interview training
- Childcare
